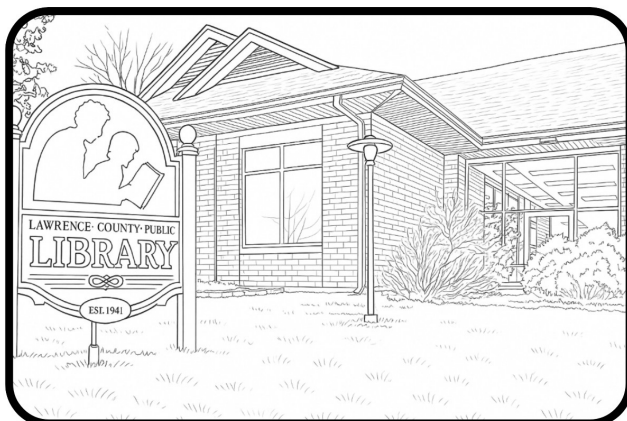

Summer is here—birds are singing, flowers are blooming, and the library is gearing up for another fun and eventful season! Many of our regular programs are continuing, and we're also excited to introduce a variety of new ones.

Our Summer reading program starts the first week of June! Are your children signed up? Children entering kindergarten – 6th grade can sign up for a reading log. When they read so many books a week they get a prize bag.

For adults our two book clubs are still going strong and we have started a new one called Book Worms! Check it out!

The Red Cross will be here in June 3rd to teach Hands-Only CPR. This class is free but space is limited. (This is an adult class for those age 16 and up)

We are very excited to have a new partnership with the American Job Center. They will be at the library to offer assistance to anyone wanting help with resumes, job searches or interview techniques. See the flyer for details. They are also running a Layoff Workshop in June on the 9th and 23rd.

In July be sure to come to our Author Meet & Greet on Saturday the 26th. We have many local and area authors who will be setting up a table in the library to meet and chat with you about their books. Spanning many genres and age groups we'll have something for everyone. Bring the children!

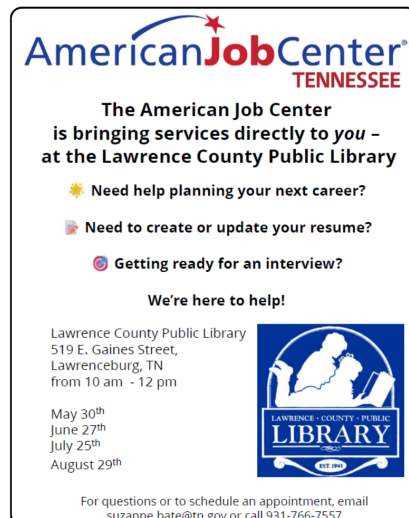

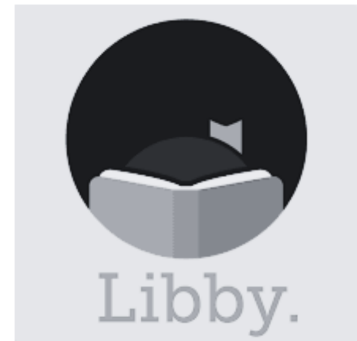
